



High performance investment approach process 2014–15

Step 1 — Annual Sports Performance Review

All sports that receive Australian Sports Commission (ASC) funding are assessed annually as part of the Annual Sports Performance Review (ASPR). The ASPR considers each sport's high performance and participation profile, governance and financial performance. The results of the 2013 ASPR are summarised in the 2014 Sports Tally.

Step 2 — Assessment against *Australia's Winning Edge* investment principles

In determining whether any changes to high performance investment recommendations are required, the AIS will assess each sport against the *Winning Edge* high performance investment principles.

Step 3 — Consideration by the ASC Sport Investment Panel

High performance investment recommendations are then considered by the ASC Sport Investment Panel, which is chaired by the AIS Deputy Director, Performance Investment and includes members of the ASC Executive.

Step 4 — Approval by the ASC Board

The recommended high performance investment allocations are presented to the ASC Board for endorsement and approval.

Step 5 — Notification and execution of funding agreements

National sporting organisations are notified of their funding investment allocations and sport investment agreements are executed.
