Follow the instructions below to make a foldout brochure to give to students in your class. If you follow the layout in this example, your brochure will be in the correct order when folded. Check with your teacher before making a full-size copy.

Side 1	<p><b>How to play:</b> Outline in short paragraphs or easy to read dot points how to play this new sport, whether it is a team or individual sport, do you play it on a field or court, and what equipment is needed</p>	<p><b>Locations to play:</b> Include information about where they can play this sport</p>	<p><b>Cover page:</b> Use lots of bright colours, design a logo for your sport, include the sport name and a picture of people playing it</p>
Side 2	<p>fold here</p> <p><b>Information about the sport:</b> Use short paragraphs to explain what this new sport is, how it was invented and why people should play it</p>	<p><b>Open day:</b> Information about your open day to demonstrate this new sport</p> <p style="text-align: right;">fold here</p>	<p><b>Testimonials:</b> Include some quotes from new players of this sport saying how easy it is to learn and how much fun it is</p> <p style="text-align: right;">fold here</p>
